Tell me about the visitors that you get here?

Well we get a huge variety of visitors really, we get quite a few overseas visitors, we get people who are here just to do a walk, we get people who come and just want to have a picnic and maybe walk to the rocks and back or even just stay in the car park and look at the view; so we get a huge range of visitors, and obviously in the peak season we get a lot of families who are maybe staying at the coast but come up here for the day or visa versa, so want advice on everything to do with Dartmoor but possibly further afield as well.

And so how busy do you get here?

Well, very weather dependent, on a good day we can get 200 people going through the Centre, maybe more 250, but we just get hundreds and hundreds of people on a sunny warm summer day, or even in the winter when it snows or if we get a bright sunny weekend, lots of walkers, and obviously we get quite a few people who cycle here, who come horse riding, who do letterboxing, so a huge range of outdoor pursuits really.
