How to get to Yarner Wood.

So how do you get to Yarner Wood?

Well if you want to get to Yarner wood by car you take the road out from Bovey Tracey towards Manaton and then about two miles along that road there's a clearly marked entrance at place called Reddaford Water and then you can just drive down the track and park in the carpark there. But if you want a nice walk taking in moorland and woodland the best thing to do is to go up to Haytor and follow the granite tramway down from Haytor Rocks down into the woodland and that walk is part of a much longer walk that's about 29 kilometres long, called the Templer Way, named after James Templer who built the canal and his son George who built the tramway, and it follows the route all the way down to the Teign Estuary, but that's a really nice way of going into Yarner Wood.
